The McKinney Performing Arts Center

I feel like we have a great home for our annual concert at the McKinney Performing Arts Center and hope you come out and join us for our November 16th show. The 1874 Collin County Courthouse has been converted into the McKinney Performing Arts Center and is on the Square in Historic Downtown McKinney. The Courtroom Theater has been restored to its 1927 condition and is perfect for a Bluegrass concert, both in terms of incredible atmosphere and great sound. It seats 264 on the main floor and 163 in the balcony and provides for an intimate setting for both performers and the audience. Brent Young recommended I check it out, although he had never been in the theater, and when we both entered for the first time Brent exclaimed "Where are the Soggy Bottom Boys?" Yes, that is atmosphere.

And if you get to the show early you will be quite pleased with the great job the City of McKinney has done restoring their historic downtown area. There are antique stores, art galleries, restaurants, and quaint shops of great variety surrounding the Square and adjacent streets.

It appears that we will also be receiving financial support thru the McKinney Arts Commission. This will allow us to provide quality entertainment at a reasonable cost to those attending our concerts. We hope to build upon this relationship over time and offer a concert each year at the theater. Both the Arts Commission and the MPAC have really made us feel welcome in McKinney and it is very encouraging.

Our approach this year was to create a show that while being fully satisfying to the expectations of a hardcore Bluegrass audience can also be appreciated by the general public. This has been accomplished by offering top quality bands that offer great variety, and by limiting the show to just two bands. Many people who otherwise want to attend a Bluegrass event may choose not to if the Bluegrass event is ten hours long. Our show offers two great bands that should please all those attending, and we hope to sell out. And selling out isn't all about money. Having a full house encourages the bands and the audiences and usually reflects that new faces are coming to check out our wonderful music. I expect this concert to be the first exposure to Bluegrass music for many,

and if they come I know they will want to come again. It is just the nature of our music when performed by two bands as great as the ones we will have. Masters of Bluegrass featuring Lou Reid and Carolina and The Byron Berline Band will perform at 6PM on November 16th.
